Resolved Issues

- Issue:** Policy migration fails for certain policies created with Host IPS 7.0. (Reference: 755156, 763627)
Resolution: Fixed a null pointer exception in the policy migrator.
- Issue:** Some policies are not viewable after being migrated from Host IPS 7.0. (Reference: 773226)
Resolution: Corrected the handling of an optional tag in the policy xml file.
- Issue:** Changes made to any predefined firewall groups are lost when the Host IPS extension is upgraded to a newer version. (Reference: 732673)
Resolution: Predefined firewall groups are no longer altered when an extension upgrade is performed.
