Resolved issues

This release resolves an issue where sendmail did not correctly handle a '\0' character in the Common Name field of an X.509 certificate (CVE-2009-4565).

This hotfix applies to installations of all McAfee DLP products on models 1650 and 3650 appliances.

Installation instructions

Use this procedure to install the hotfix.

Before you begin

- Download the hotfix.
- Stop all scans and search tasks, and wait until they are completely stopped.

Task

- 1 Using a command line session, log on to the appliance as root.
- 2 Make an installation directory.

```
# mkdir /tmp/hotfix
```

3 Copy the hotfix archive to the appliance.

If you downloaded the archive to a Windows-based computer, use WinSCP to copy it to the /tmp/hotfix directory.

If you downloaded the archive to a Linux server, log on to the server and use the SCP command.

```
# scp -rp <hotfix_package> root@<name or ip address>:/tmp/hotfix
```

4 Go to the /tmp/hotfix directory.

```
# cd /tmp/hotfix
```

5 Extract the contents of the archive.

```
# tar xvzf hotfix_<#####_#####_##>.tar.gz
```

where <#####_#####_##> represents the hotfix number in the file name shown on the first page of this document.

6 Review the README file to view the hotfix details.

7 Run the installation script.

```
# ./install_hotfix
```

8 Restart the stingray service.

```
# service stingray restart
```

The hotfix is installed.
