Task

- 1 Download
McAfee-Threat-Prevention-for-Mac-10.2.3-standalone-<build_number>-<HF_Number>.dmg to a temporary location on your Mac, then double-click it to mount the hotfix package.
- 2 Double-click
McAfee-Threat-Prevention-for-Mac-10.2.3-standalone-<build_number>-<HF_Number>.pkg to open the wizard, then follow the on-screen instructions.

Install the software through McAfee ePO

Install the hotfix through McAfee ePO.

Before you begin

If the HF1219497 and HF1217725 packages are already checked in to the Master Repository in McAfee ePO, before checking in this hotfix, you must remove the HF1219497 and HF1217725 from the Master Repository.

Task

- 1 Download the
McAfee-Threat-Prevention-for-Mac-10.2.3-<build_number>-ePO-client-package-<HF_Number>.zip file to a temporary directory on the McAfee ePO system.
- 2 Log on to the McAfee ePO server as an administrator.
- 3 Click **Menu | Software | Master Repository**.
- 4 Click **Actions | Check In Package**. The Package page appears.
- 5 From Package type, select **Product or Update (.ZIP)**.

- 6 From File path, click **Browse** and select the file
McAfee-Threat-Prevention-for-Mac-10.2.3-<build_number>-ePO-client-package-<HF_Number>.zip.
- 7 Click **Open**, then click **Next**. The Package Options page appears.
- 8 Select the appropriate branch, then click **Save**.
- 9 Create an Update task and deploy this hotfix package.
